LIFESTYLE & IMPROV AUDITIONING FOR ADULTS

This in person workshop will focus on lifestyle and improvisation auditions. Actors will learn how to prepare for auditions when there is minimal or no dialogue.

Focus areas:

- Different types of lifestyle spots
- How to mine the script for clues
- How to maximize the moments that get you noticed
- When and how to use dialogue during improv

Talent will have an opportunity to work on multiple spots and receive feedback on their auditions. Practical workshop time will be followed by a Q&A.

COLD READING WORKSHOP
